SPECTATORS' CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1.1 Spectators are to abide by the Club Rules of Maroochy Beach Gymnastics Club
- 1.2 No smoking in the building or within 4 metres of the outer parameter. Refer to Smoke-Free Policy.
- 1.3 No alcohol is to be consumed on the premise without prior consent of the Management Committee
- 1.4 The gym floor is the domain of gymnasts & coaches only. Spectators are not to enter the training area unless invited by the coach. This is a safety rule.
- 1.5 Under no circumstance is any person granted permission to play on any equipment.
- 1.6 Aggressive, threatening or other inappropriate behaviour by members, their families, their friends, and other sporting personnel while attending a game or event will not be tolerated. These behaviours include:
 - using bad language
 - harassing or ridiculing athletes, coaches, officials or other spectators
 - making racist, religious, sexist or other inappropriate comments to athletes, coaches, officials or other spectators
 - any threatening behaviour or physical altercation between spectators and athletes, coaches, officials or other spectators
 - putting undue pressure on children, berating them or putting down their performance
- 1.7 Under no circumstance is anyone permitted to play in the car park
- 1.8 No talking to gymnasts or coaches during class or competition
- 1.9 Keep the viewing area as clean as possible. Remove your rubbish from the seating area and use the bins provided
- 1.10 Parents & family members are welcome to view classes and/or competition however parents are responsible for any children and must ensure they do not disrupt classes.
- 1.11 Please switch mobile phones to silent & keep noise to a minimum.
