At Maroochy Beach Gymnastics, we are committed to providing a safe, inclusive, fair, and supportive environment for all members, athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers, and families.

What is an MPIO?

A Member Protection Information Officer (MPIO) is an impartial support person who is available to listen to concerns raised by members and provide information about the options available to them.

MPIOs help individuals understand their rights, responsibilities, and the processes available for addressing concerns within sport. They can provide guidance and refer people to the appropriate person or organisation for further support or resolution.

MPIOs do not:


- investigate complaints
- determine outcomes
- mediate disputes
- make decisions on behalf of the club

The MPIO role is separate from the Club's Complaints Manager and formal complaints handling process. Their role is to provide confidential information and support, and to help people navigate the appropriate pathways.
